URGENT: Motion of No- Confidence scheduled for 18 April 2017

We refer to your letter dated 12 April 2017 received today at 15h00.

We confirm that our instructions are that the debate and vote on the motion of no confidence is postponed pending consideration of the matter by the Programme Committee after the constituency period.

The Programme Committee will be requested to consider two issues, namely the implications of the postponement of the motion of no confidence, especially in light of Rule 90 (rule of anticipation), and a possible date in the future for the consideration of the motion. This is in keeping with section 57 of the Constitution which provides that the National Assembly has the power to determine and control its internal arrangements, proceedings and procedures.
